Supervisor Gozelski called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM.

PUBLIC HEARING – LOCAL LAW 1 – 2009, AMENDING LOCAL LAW #2 – 1993, LAND
USE LAW OF THE TOWN OF CASTILE

The hearing was opened at 7:03 PM by Supervisor Gozelski. The Clerk read the notice of public hearing as published in the Perry Herald on April 2, 2009. No comments were given at this time.

The Highway Superintendent was first appointed with a two year term which began in May 2003. The Supervisor stated that according to Town law, the Highway Superintendent’s appointment ends December 31, 2009 and not April 30, 2009.

Motion was made by Coun. Klein, but not seconded, resolved to reappoint Christopher Foley as Highway Superintendent for the term of 5/1/2009 – 4/30/2011 with commendation for his good work.

Motion was made by Coun. Tarbell, seconded by Coun. Little, resolved to appoint Vicki Draper as Deputy Town Clerk.

Coun. Little as Town Historian explained that she would be attending the meeting of the Allegany County Historians on April 23rd in Belmont on the subject of historical resources. She also will be attending the meeting of a new group, Government Appointed Historians of WNY, in Batavia on May 9th.

Coun. Klein stated nothing has been heard from the DEC regarding the dredging of the Silver Lake outlet.

PWMS Kibler reported that on March 11th his assistant, the Hwy Supt, and himself attended water operator training put on by the Wyoming County Department of Health. On March 26th the ice was gone on Silver Lake. He had to reset the pumps after the lightning storm on March 8th and on March 9th after the heavy rain.

The Supervisor reported that the Middle Reservation Road construction will start in June. Stone is already being stockpiled. The portion of the new road in the Village is being questioned due to the age of the water lines. It is also being questioned because of the water lines which will be installed to Letchworth State Park on (1) Buffalo Street and on to DeGolyer Road and (2) on Glen Iris Road.

The paving of East Lake Road will include 4 miles from Route 19A to Route 39. The Supervisor is getting the right-of-ways signed. The Agreement to Spend Town Highway Funds was signed by the Board agreeing with the County to spend \$125,000 on Chamberlain Road.

Motion was made by Coun. Monteleone, seconded by Coun. Tarbell, resolved to advertise for bids to be returned by May 14, 2009 at 7:00 PM for the purchase of unleaded gasoline and on road ultra low sulfur diesel fuel grade 2 – preferred.
